

Do You Want to Be a City Councilor?

Sanford City Council is looking for candidates to fill a vacancy on the City Council until the end of 2023. This vacancy occurred when Mayor Brink, formerly Councilor Brink, gave up her Council seat to take her position as Mayor pursuant to Section 212 of the Sanford City Charter. Under the Charter, the Council may choose to fill such a vacancy by appointment. The appointed Councilor will serve until the end of the year, at which point a candidate elected in November will take over the position. The appointed Councilor may choose to run for election to continue to serve in the position for the remainder of the vacant term, which runs through December 2024.

Candidates for the position of City Councilor must be qualified Voters in Sanford and shall have their principal place of residence in the City during their terms of office. No Councilor, including the Mayor, may hold any other paid office or position of employment with the City or School Department.

Letters of interest will be reviewed by the Council's Applications Committee, and selected Candidates will each meet with the full City Council for a public conversation on March 14. A vote on appointment to fill the vacancy will be taken at the regular City Council Meeting on March 21.
